



Capital Outlay

- Purchased Services
- Supplies & Materials

### Federal Government IDEA-B Funding

- Salaries
  - Instruction
    - Speech & Language Therapists (\$65,000)
  - Support Services
    - 51% salary for H/I aides (\$296,548)
  - Supplemental Summer testing (\$14,000)
  - Governance Special Services Secretary (\$30,000)

### Federal Government IDEA-B Funding

- Purchase of Services
  - Professional Development (\$4,000)
  - Consultants (\$17,000)
  - Maintenance of Equipment (\$500)

## **IDEA-B** Funding

- Capital Outlay
  - Instruction (\$7,500)
    - Computers and other assistive devices for special education classes
    - Augmentative devices
    - Adaptive seating and equipment
    - Amplification systems

### **IDEA-B** Funding

- Supplies/Materials (\$21,500)
  - Curriculum supports (\$5,500)
  - Testing supplies (\$8,000)
  - Software (\$8,000)
    - News to You, EdHelper, Boardmaker, Write Out Loud, DT Trainer, IEP writer



## State of Ohio Preschool Unit Funding

- Funded by "Unit"
  - "Unit" = Teacher or Related Service Provider

#### Aurora's Funding

- Requested Funding for 2.00 units
- Received Funding for 1 unit
- Total for Preschool unit \$40,509.16
- Preschool students = 60

### State of Ohio Catastrophic Costs

- Supplemental payment to districts to help support high cost students
  - Educational and related expenses exceed \$27,375 for students in most disability categories
  - Children with Autism Spectrum, TBI, or Deaf/Blind whose expenses exceed \$32,850

### State of Ohio Catastrophic Costs

- For 2010-2011 school year
  - Submitted reimbursement request for 42 students
  - Educational expenses totaled \$2,058,382
  - Reimbursement requests \$410,516
  - State reimbursed \$66,980

#### State of Ohio - Transportation

- Transportation Reimbursement \$53,629.68
  - Preschool

- Special Needs Bus
- CEVEC and LEAP (Kent, OH)


